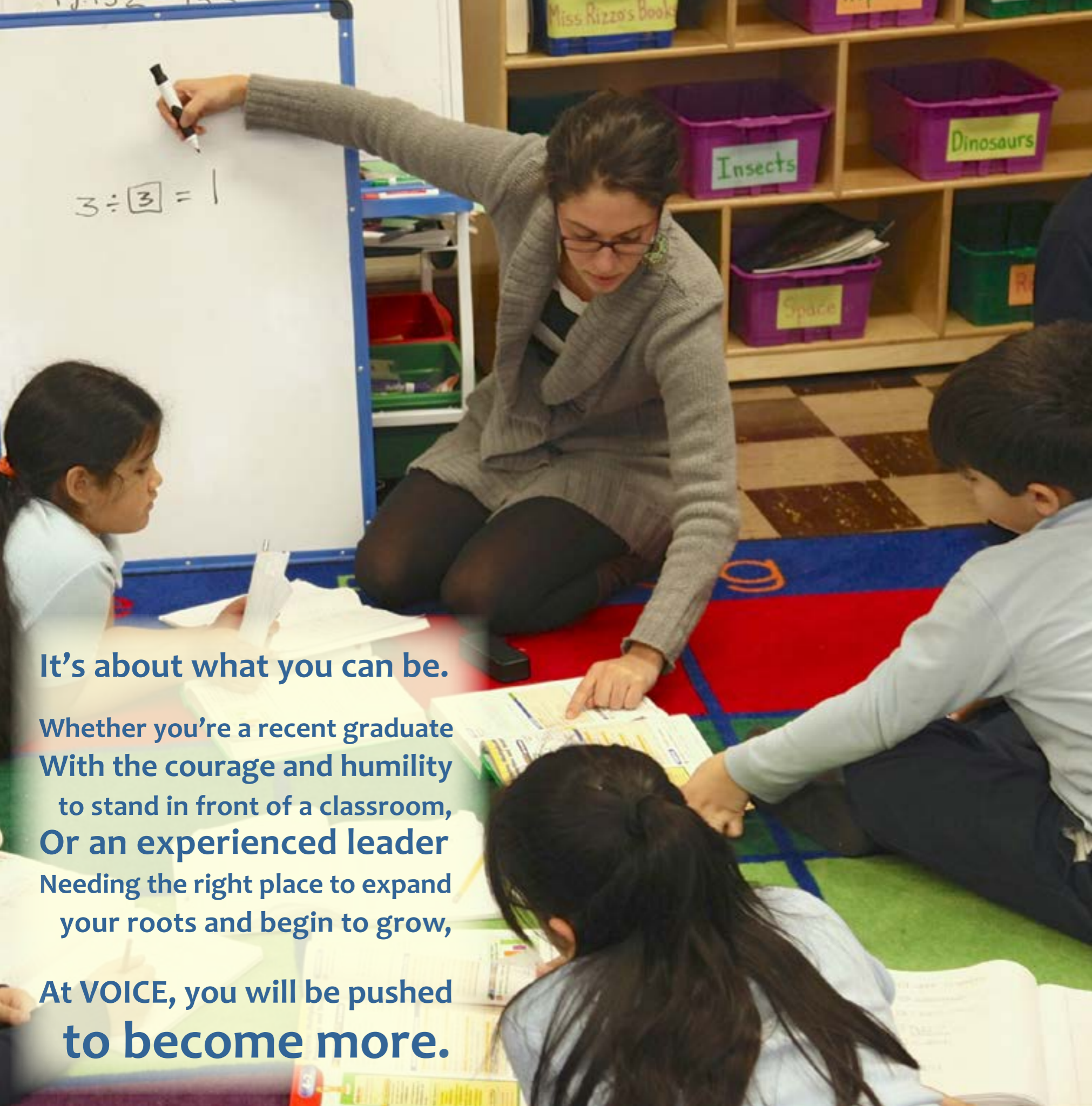






It's about what you can be.
